#### Locations

This category contains information about locations across Nova Scotia, and select locations in Canada and across the world. The types of materials that can be found in Locations includes, but is not limited to: histories, heritage registration related materials, maps, newspaper clippings, walking tours, promotional materials—including historic tourism information materials, and more.

## Organization:

Items are organized by location. Nova Scotia is first, followed by materials about Canada, materials about the United States of America and the lastly the rest of the world organized alphabetically by country name.

Locations in NS are organized alphabetically by county with the exception of Halifax Regional Municipality which is listed last.

In areas where there are a large number of records, files may be broken down by town or street address. For example, material relating to Kings County will be filed as:

- Kings County
- · Kings County Clippings
- Kings County Tours
- Kings County Grand Pre Clippings
- · Kings County Wolfville
- Kings County Wolfville Clippings

Locations within HRM are organized by neighbourhood and address. For example, material relating to the Halifax Memorial Library will be filed as:

- HRM Downtown Halifax, 5381 Spring Garden Road
- HRM Downtown Halifax, 5381 Spring Garden Road Clippings

#### Alternate Names:

For locations that have a name associated with them that is different from their street address or had a previous street address in the past (e.g. 1588 Barrington Street has been known as the "Church of England Institute", the "Khyber Building", and the "Turret Art Space"), this information is included in the Alternate Names / Previous Street Addresses field.
